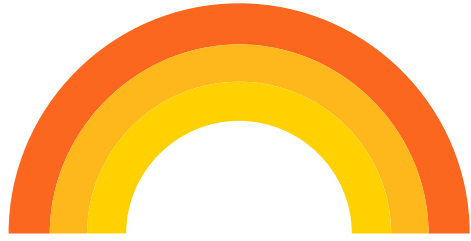

Tips on Submission

To celebrate Children's Week, children and young people across Australia are invited to participate in sharing their voice through art & creative expression.

Here are some tips on submitting artwork to the showcase

1 This year we're asking for artworks that represent friendship. Artists might want to create art or a story about a friend, someone they wish was a friend of theirs, something they love about a friend or how a friend makes the artist feel.

2 Every artist who creates a submission will also receive a special gift for themselves and a friend.

3 Enjoy using different mediums they enjoy including drawing, writing, painting and other visual arts.

4 All submissions must have permission of a parent or guardian. By making a submission that adult agrees to our terms & conditions which can be found at www.childhood.org.au/creative-showcase/

5 When submitting visual art, try scanning images or taking high-resolution photos that look great when blown up large on a computer.

6 Works can be submitted via our website or posted in to PO Box 3335 Richmond VIC 3121 (Sorry, we won't be able to return any creative works so make sure you take a photo or keep a copy).

7 To be fair to all our artists, please only submit a maximum of 5 entries per person.
